
## BUTTERNUT PUMPKIN LINUS





A hybrid Waltham type but with a much thicker neck, **LINUS** provides growers with a much higher yield and an improved pack out due to the greater uniformity in fruit size and shape. With an average fruit weight of approximately 1.7kg, **LINUS** has the ability to be sold by piece or as a cut product.

Excellent flesh quality is a key feature of **LINUS** with a deep orange colour and firm texture. A small seed cavity gives a more desirable flesh to weight ratio and improves recoveries for processing. Highly adaptable, **LINUS** can be grown in a range of growing situations.
