

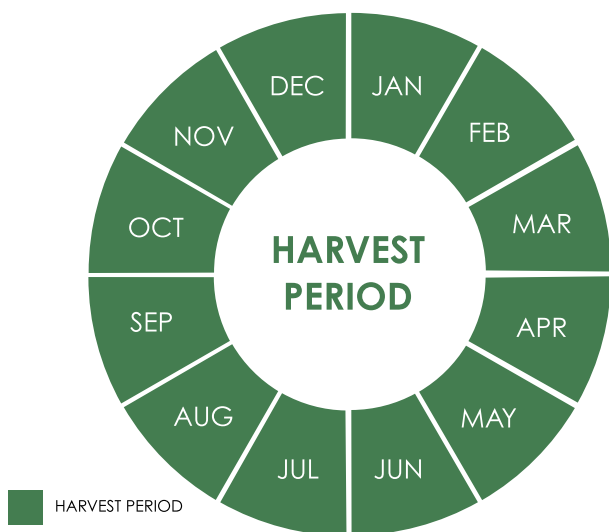
# BABYLEAF MUSTARD

## CHOP SUEY



**CHOP SUEY** is a dark coloured tatsoi with moderate vigour that is suitable for year round baby leaf production. **CHOP SUEY** has strong field tolerance to downy mildew in cooler weather conditions and is tolerant to yellowing during periods of heavy rain. **CHOP SUEY** is very uniform at harvest and holds well in warm conditions.

The upright growth of the leaves makes for easy harvesting. The leaves of **CHOP SUEY** are round to oval in shape and have a very faint serrated margin. Growers currently using a more expensive pak choi in their mix will be impressed with the similarity **CHOP SUEY** shows.
