
BABYLEAF MUSTARD

CHOP SUEY



CHOP SUEY is a dark coloured tatsoi with moderate vigour that is suitable for year round babyleaf production. CHOP SUEY has strong field tolerance to downy mildew in cooler weather conditions and is tolerant to yellowing during periods of heavy rain. CHOP SUEY is very uniform at harvest and holds well in warm conditions.

The upright growth of the leaves makes for easy harvesting. The leaves of **CHOP SUEY** are round to oval in shape and have a very faint serrated margin. Growers currently using a more expensive pak choi in their mix will be impressed with the similarity **CHOP SUEY** shows.
