

ROCKMELON INFINITE GOLD



INFINITE GOLD is a Harper type rockmelon and has been bred for flavour, fruit quality and long shelf life (LSL) with a strong disease package of powdery mildew (Px) and Fusarium (Fom). **INFINITE GOLD** is a highly adaptable variety and has shown very good tolerance to ground cracking.

The non-sutured fruit have a full net and are produced on a vigorous vine, setting mostly on the crown. Highly uniform fruit size and shape, in addition to high yield potential, are key features of **INFINITE GOLD**.

The fruit are large in size and can reach a Brix of 12-14 at correct maturity under favourable conditions. The flesh is firm with a dark orange colour and a small seed cavity.
