
WATERMELON FIREBALL




A hybrid, Sugar Baby type, **FIREBALL** produces high yields of consistently uniform fruit.

A vigorous plant with a good canopy, **FIREBALL** can be grown for early or main season production.

The fruit of **FIREBALL** have a deep red flesh which contrasts well with the dark green rind. Flesh is firm and very sweet with excellent eating qualities.

FIREBALL has shown good tolerance to hollowing, important for markets who wish to display cut fruit.

Fruit set is excellent and melons will typically mature around 12 weeks from transplanting.
