GRAVLAX is a high quality dill, bred especially for production under high bolting pressure, and therefore able to have a longer cutting time. A tetraploid type, **GRAVLAX** is suitable for warm season production and will perform well in greenhouse or open field environments.

GRAVLAX produces fine, dark green, feathered leaves with a high leaf-to-stem ratio, making it well suited to sleeving and potted production. **GRAVLAX** is high yielding and has a subtle flavour and attractive presentation.

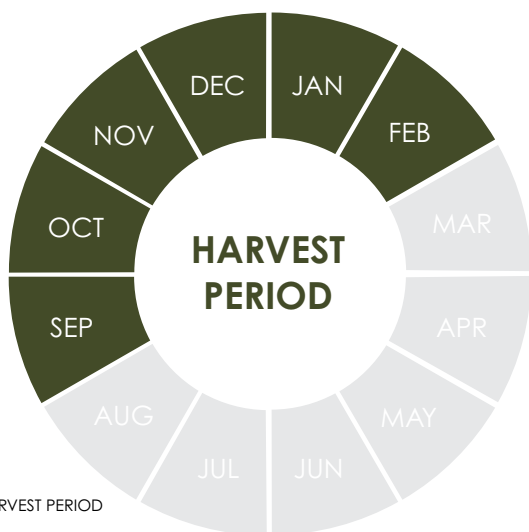
