

CABBAGE RED CRIMSON EMERALD



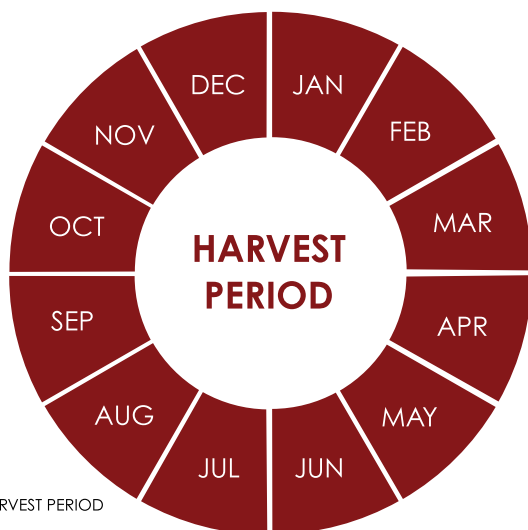
CRIMSON EMERALD is a large red cabbage which produces a globe head shape with a weight of 3 - 5 kg.

Producing a large, upright frame with a large dense head, **CRIMSON EMERALD** can be used successfully for both the process and fresh market segments.

Good vigour is a key attribute of **CRIMSON EMERALD** and it can be grown throughout the cooler months.

This variety also shows extremely good field holding ability in warmer conditions.

This variety has shown good field tolerance to black rot.
